'Breaking the Code' is the story of Alan Turing, the brilliant mathematician, who helped create the machine to crack the German Enigma code during the war, and then came to Manchester to work on the development of the modern computer. The story ends with the sad humiliation of his prosecution and early death.

This is the first major revival of Hugh Whitemore's classic play, 30 years after it was first performed with Derek Jacobi in it central role.


This is a matinee performance, which always seems to be popular, and as this concert is so close to Christmas, it should be a wonderful way to start Christmas festivities.
