On arrival at 84, Plymouth Grove where Elizabeth Gaskell lived and which has been beautifully restored with spectacular period rooms and a garden we will have tea/coffee and biscuits followed by a guided tour.

Then on to Ordsall Hall, Salford's Grade 1 listed Manor House which is now a Heritage Site surrounded by landscaped gardens. It has undergone a £6.5 million restoration project. On arrival we will have a light lunch of sandwiches, salad, crisps and cake, with tea/coffee, followed by a guided tour of the building.

The cost of this outing is £24pp, and includes coach travel, morning coffee/tea, lunch and tours of both venues The coach will leave Knutsford Bus station at 9.30 am and we should be back in Knutsford by 4.
