December 14th

Speaker: Geoff Scargill - 'The Last Laugh of the Railway King '
A look at the life of Sir Edward Watkin 1819-1901

Sir Edward Watkin MP, who lived and died in Northenden, is a forgotten great man of the nineteenth century. He started to dig a Channel Tunnel, erected an Eiffel Tower in London and led the campaign to provide parks for the people of Manchester. That is just a selection of his amazing schemes!

Geoff Scargill has been our meeting speaker several times. He is a retired Head teacher and Magistrate. His interests are politics, cricket and local history. All proceeds from his talks go to cancer research.

2018 January 11th

Unfortunately our scheduled speaker, Roger Smith, has had to cancel his booking with us.

David Coggar, one of our members, has kindly offered to step into the breach and will be speaking at our meeting in January. The title of his talk is: 'Two things my teachers never mentioned: Coastal Change and Climate Change'

February 8th

Speaker: Geoff Holman - "Shakespeare - the Director? "

Shakespeare's text gives clear clues to actors as to how he wanted a line to be handled, or even how a scene should be paced. This talk will show and discuss how, from 400 years away, Shakespeare can still be the director at your shoulder with helpful advice.

Geoff Holman started his working life as a biochemist in medical research and spent most of his career working for ICI Pharmaceuticals (now AstraZeneca). In parallel with this he did a lot of directing and acting at the Garrick Theatre in Altrincham. He took early retirement to study for an MA in Contemporary Theatre Practice, specialising in the 20th century production and teaching of Shakespeare. He then undertook training in acting at Birmingham School of Speech and Drama.

He has been asked to talk about the actor's approach to Shakespeare's text on numerous occasions, in particular by the Manchester Literary and Philosophical Society.
