Their conversations are delightfully interrupted by 17 other personalities: Denis Thatcher, the Reagans, Rupert Murdoch, Kenneth Kaunda, Michelle Obama, to name but a few, all depicted by just two actors and many hats!

This is an 'in house' production by the New Vic Theatre of a play which has been well received since it first appeared in 2013, playing in the West End for twelve months, with many positive reviews praising its humour as well as its subject matter. The New Vic rarely lets us down and hopefully they have chosen well with this one.

The weather was perfect for walking, the scenery on both sides of the ridge was spectacular and the group enjoyed a lunch stop with sweeping views of the valley. The second group of walkers stayed on the coach as far as Edale where, after a coffee stop, they did a slightly shorter, low level circular walk which also included some lovely scenery and a lunch stop. Wendy, our very obliging coach driver, then had to take us back to Knutsford via a very circuitous route as, by that time, Whaley Bridge had been completely closed off due to the danger of the dam bursting.
