

Proposed itinerary

Monday Day 1 – Departing Knutsford approx. 8.30am we journey south, making a comfort stop en route to Stamford. Lunch can be purchased here before an included 90-minute guided walking tour of this Lincolnshire gem. You will be given an entertaining and informative narration of the architecture, characters and legends of one of the finest stone towns in England. Stamford has preserved a multitude of Georgian buildings built on a medieval base with Tudor and Victorian interludes. The town has a vibrant history, much of which is still visible in the 600 listed buildings and monuments. Continuing on to Norwich and your centrally located hotel, your evening meal is included.

Tuesday Day 2 – Breakfast included. This morning's included visit it to **Royal Sandringham House, Museum & Gardens**, the Royal Family's country retreat (entrance included). Originally built in 1870, Sandringham has been passed down through four generations of British monarchs. The house is surrounded by 60 acres of glorious gardens and the museum features a collection of Royal cars as well as much more. Lunch can be purchased here before returning to Norwich for an included visit to the **Sainsbury Centre Visual Arts Centre.** This is one of the most prominent university art galleries in Britain, and a major national centre for the study and presentation of art, housing the extraordinary art collection of Robert and Lisa Sainsbury, as well as the Anderson Collection of Art Nouveau and the University's Abstract and Constructivist Collection. Hotel dinner included.

Wednesday Day 3 - Breakfast included. This morning is a leisurely one as we travel to Horning, a picturesque waterside Broads village for an included 1½ hour cruise on the Southern Comfort, a double-deck paddle boat purpose built for the Broads, with on board commentary. On disembarkation, there will be a little free time to purchase lunch in a waterside pub or tea-room before continuing on to Blickling Hall & Estate (NT). Follow 400 years of history, from the Boleyn family to the RAF and WWII. Learn what life was like as a servant and hear the stories of the real people who kept Blickling going. Explore the Long Gallery which holds the most important book collection in the National Trust. The estate is a treasure trove of romantic buildings, beautiful and extensive gardens and landscaped park. A hotel dinner is included this evening.

Thursday Day 4 - Breakfast included. Today is dedicated to the historic City of Norwich, with its many famous landmarks. Included is a guided visit of Norwich Cathedral, the most complete Norman cathedral in England with over 900 years of history. Discover the largest cathedral close and monastic cloister in England. The remainder of the day is at your leisure to explore enchanting cobbled streets and fascinating historical buildings & museums. You might choose to visit Norwich Castle, built by the Normans as a Royal Palace 900 years ago. Explore the Castle's history as a palace and later as a prison, and enjoy their fabulous collections of fine art, archaeology, and natural history as well as the Royal Norfolk Regimental Museum collections. Strangers' Hall was for centuries the home of wealthy merchants and mayors of Norwich. Step back in time and explore this rambling medieval town house with its maze of rooms furnished in the styles of many different historical periods, from Tudor to Victorian. From Medieval to modern day, the Museum of Norwich tells the story of the city's industries and the people who lived and worked here. From the textile trade which was at the heart of the city's wealth, to the production of shoes, chocolate and mustard, the story of how Norwich constantly adapted to changing fortunes and how it coped with two World Wars, told in 10 galleries over 2 floors. (Entrances except the Cathedral are all payable locally). Returning to the hotel to freshen, this evening includes a 'private finale' dinner at the Assembly House in the heart of Norwich. The Assembly House is the city's most prestigious address and has been the venue for legendary parties, dances, dinners and celebrations throughout its glittering history. The house has hosted Madame Tussaud, composer Franz Liszt and countless lavish balls, including Norfolk's spectacular celebration of Nelson's Trafalgar victory. You will be returned to the hotel later this evening.

Friday Day 5 – Breakfast included. Checking out of the hotel we retrace our steps homewards making a stop at the **International Bomber Command Centre** in Lincolnshire. During WWII over a million men and women came from 62 nations across the world, united in their efforts to protect the freedom we enjoy today. Bomber Command suffered the highest losses of any unit during WWII and has struggled for recognition. Every member of Bomber Command aircrew was a volunteer with the average age at death being only 23. The spire memorial is the UK's tallest memorial and is based on the dimensions of the wingspan of a Lancaster bomber – 102ft high and 16ft wide at the base. The spire is encircled by walls carrying the names of all 57,871 men and women who gave their lives whilst serving in or supporting Bomber Command. A **private light lunch** is included before returning to your original departure point(s).
